10:15 - Tim Hines - NGOs working with NGO's, NGO's working with government. People working with NGOs. How can we UNITE.

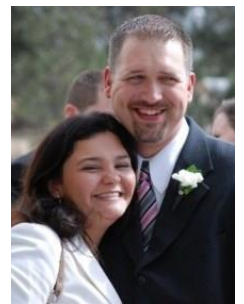
